The 3-hour Reading Practicum may be taken concurrently with the M401 field experience, WITH the following conditions:

- The only other courses taken during that semester are: Specialized methods, M464 and M401.
- All reading courses except M464 are completed with an average grade of A- in those courses and a B average in all methods courses
- Students are strongly urged not to have outside employment during the Reading Practicum

The Reading Practicum can be completed after student teaching.
