Process:

Please complete the loan application below to apply for a Federal Direct PLUS Loan for undergraduate students. Completing the PLUS Request is required to begin the application process. The parent applying for the loan must be the natural, adoptive parent or the legal guardian of the student. Once your application is received, your information will be submitted to the U.S. Department of Education who will run a credit check to determine your loan eligibility. First time borrowers, under the PLUS Loan program, will be notified to complete their Master Promissory Note (MPN) before funds may be disbursed. In cases where a refund may remain after IU charges are paid, the refund will be issued directly to the parent borrower.

Any person who knowingly makes a false statement or misrepresentation of information pertaining to the PLUS Request Form shall be subject to cancellation of further financial assistance, liable for repayment of financial assistance received, and/or subject to penalties, including suspension or expulsion from the university, according to the Indiana University *Code of Student Ethics*. Applicants who purposely falsify draft registration status will be subject to fines or imprisonment, or both, under federal regulations. If required, the student must provide proof of draft registration compliance and/or proof of the accuracy of the financial data submitted.

Information on the Privacy Act and use of your Social Security Number

We use the information that you provide on this form to determine if you are eligible to receive federal student financial aid and the amount that you are eligible to receive. Sections 483 and 484 of the Higher Education Act of 1965, as amended, give us the authority to ask you and your parents these questions, and to collect the Social Security Numbers of you and your parents. We use your Social Security Number to verify your identity and retrieve your records, and we may request your Social Security Number again for these purposes.

Without your consent, we may disclose information that you provide to entities under a published "routine use". Under such a routine use, we may disclose information to third parties that we have authorized to assist us in administering the above programs; to other federal agencies under computer matching programs, such as those with the Internal Revenue Service, Social Security Administration, Selective Service System, Immigration and Naturalization Service, and Veterans Administration; to your parents or spouse; and to members of Congress if you ask them to help you with your student aid questions.

If the federal government, the U.S. Department of Education, or an employee of the U.S. Department of Education is involved in litigation, we may send information to the Department of Justice or a court or adjudicative body, if the disclosure is related to financial aid and certain conditions are met. In addition, we may send your information to a foreign, federal, state or local enforcement agency if the information that you submitted indicates a violation or potential violation of law, for which that agency has jurisdiction for investigation or prosecution. Finally, we may send information regarding a claim that is determined to be valid and overdue to a consumer reporting agency. This information includes identifiers from the record; the amount; status; and history of the claim; and the program under which the claim arose.

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
