

**Recommendation to the Chancellor Regarding Academic Long
Range Planning
(5-2-00)**

Basic assumptions:

1. Academic long range planning should not be sundered from long range planning for the campus as a whole.
2. Academic long range planning should involve input from constituencies other than (i.e., in addition to) faculty.
3. Academic long range planning should be driven by and overseen by faculty.

Recommendation: Academic long range planning should be part of the charge of the Long Range Planning Committee appointed by the Chancellor. The Chancellor should appoint to that committee no fewer than three (3) faculty members. Those faculty members should come from three different divisions, and two (2) of them should also be elected members of the Faculty Senate Curriculum Committee, on staggered appointments.

Rationale: This recommendation satisfies the three basic assumptions listed above. It also assures communication between the Long Range Planning Committee and the Curriculum Committee on matters pertaining to academics.
