

## **IUE Constitution Article VII**

### **Current Policy**

Amendments to the Constitution shall be enacted upon approval by two-thirds majority of the voting membership of the Senate in a Senate meeting or by means of ballots circulated by the President of the Faculty Senate. When a quorum is present, amendments to the Bylaws to the Constitution shall be enacted upon approval of a majority of those voting members. (Passed by the IU East Faculty Senate 2/17/98)

### **Proposed Change**

Amendments to the Constitution shall be enacted, with previous notice to the faculty, upon approval by a two-thirds vote of the Senate members attending the meeting. Amendments to Bylaws to the Constitution shall be enacted, with previous notice to the faculty, upon approval by a majority vote of those attending the meeting.
