

Academic Handbook VII – By-Laws

Current statement:

C. Faculty Affairs Committee: This shall be concerned with the Academic Handbook and general welfare, working conditions, and professional development. The Faculty Affairs Committee shall have oversight responsibility for the systematic faculty review of the Vice Chancellor for Academic Affairs and Division Chairs and Deans. (Passed by the IU East Faculty Senate 11/02/99)

Proposed statement:

C. Faculty Affairs committee : ~~The Faculty Affairs committee shall consist of as many as 5 elected faculty members.~~ Each member will serve two-year staggered terms. The sixth member shall be the UFC representative serving ex-officio.

This committee shall be concerned with the Academic Handbook and the general welfare and working conditions of the faculty.

This committee shall:

- recommend to Faculty Senate policies and procedures dealing with working conditions, faculty promotion, tenure, dismissal, academic freedom, faculty conduct and other appropriate matters relating to faculty
- review and revise policy statements in the Academic handbook on all matters pertaining to faculty
- have the oversight responsibility for the systematic review of faculty supervisors such as the Vice-Chancellor for Academic Affairs, Division Chairs and Deans. ~~and Directors.~~
