

Current Constitutional Amendments
(Passed by Faculty Senate February 26, 2002)

Section 6.3

Members of standing committees of the Indiana University East Faculty Senate shall serve two year terms with half of the members being elected each year. Elections shall be held during the April Faculty Senate meeting and new members shall begin service on July 1, unless a different starting date is designated in the by-laws of that committee. Chairs of committees shall be elected by the members of the committee from those members in their second year of service.

Section 6.6 Committee Chairperson Selection

The President of the Faculty Senate shall call the first meeting of the Admissions and Academic Affairs, Budgetary Affairs, Curriculum, Faculty Affairs, and Workload committees no later than one week following the first Senate meeting and preside over the selection of new Chairpersons.

Section 6.3

Members of standing committees of the Indiana University East Faculty Senate shall serve two-year terms with half of the members being elected each year. Elections shall be held during the April Faculty Senate meeting and new members shall begin service on July 1, unless a different election date or starting date is designated in the Faculty Senate by-laws of that committee. The President of the Faculty Senate will call the first meeting of each newly elected standing committee within one week of its election. During that meeting the members of each committee shall elect the chair of the committee from those members who have completed at least one year of service.
