

## Deviations from Degree Requirements

{EFS 11/19/82} Requests to deviate from any Indiana University East degree requirement must be recommended, in writing, by the Dean of the School from which the student is obtaining the degree. Deviations from degree requirements should be uncommon. There should be compelling reasons to recommend a deviation.

The recommendation will be made in consultation with appropriate faculty and advisors. When multiple Schools are involved all Deans of said Schools must consent to the deviation.

The recommended deviation will be sent to the Executive Vice Chancellor for Academic Affairs (EVCAA). The EVCAA will make the final determination regarding the proposed deviation.

Documentation of any deviations from degree requirement requests and the final decision will be placed in the student's official advising file.
