

Policy for Jointly Offered Graduate/Undergraduate Courses

Courses listed in the IU East Bulletin that are jointly offered with undergraduate and graduate course numbers will have differentiated requirements. These courses will require a higher level of performance and significantly more work at the graduate level for the graduate students than for the undergraduates. The syllabus for the course must clearly outline the extra work required of graduate students. Examples of additional work required of graduate students might include any of the following: increased number of readings, additional research based assignments, additional papers or projects, extra class sessions, additional in-class leadership roles, oral class presentations, etc.
