General Requirements

A student working toward a Bachelor of Science in Business Administration Degree (BS in Business Administration) at Indiana University East (IUE) must fulfill the following requirements:

- a. 120 semester hours with a minimum GPA of 2.0, with at least 30 hours at IU East.
- b. Complete the major in Business Administration. No business division course with a grade below 2.0 can be counted toward a business degree.
- c. Complete IUE general education (sections A-F) with a minimum GPA of 2.0 in courses with an asterisk. A cumulative GPA of 2.0 in general education courses is required.
