### FOUR COURSE CERTIFICATE

The Four Course Certificate is for the student pursuing a concurrent degree in any area. It is also appropriate for the student who has completed a degree and wishes a concentration in this area.

- HSRV-H 204      Introduction to Gerontology (3cr)
- PSY- B 354      Adult Development and Aging (3cr)
- HSRV-H 301      Service Needs of Older Adults (3cr)
- HSRV-H 303      Counseling Needs of Older Adults (3cr)

Two of the courses can be worked into the Human Services degree requirements. H204 (Introduction to Gerontology) satisfy the Special Topic (S200) requirement and B354 (Adult Development and Aging) satisfies the Social/Behavioral requirement.

Certificates are awarded when classes are completed, even though a student is still working toward a degree.
