### **Minor in Political Science**

**Purpose:** The Political Science Minor is designed to:

- A. Support and enhance a variety of baccalaureate majors;
- B. Provide recognition to those students who enjoy Political Science and wish to complete a series of classes, regardless of their major, and
- C. Offer students interested in Political Science a group of courses which can become the basis of a concentration in Political Science within the Bachelor of Science in Behavioral and Social Sciences.

**Requirements:** The minor in Political Science requires 18 hours of coursework with a “C+” (2.3) or better and each individual course grade must be a “C” (2.0) or better.

Required:     Y103 – Introduction to American Politics     (3 cr.)  
                  Y105 – Introduction to Political Philosophy   (3 cr.)  
                  Y107 – Introduction to Comparative Gov.     (3 cr.)
