REQUIREMENTS FOR
MINOR IN ECONOMICS

Students who elect to minor in economics must complete at least 18 credit hours of course work as follows:

- I. E103 Introduction to Microeconomics (3 cr.)
- E104 Introduction to Macroeconomics (3 cr.)
- E270 Introduction to Statistical Theory in Economics and Business (3 cr.)
- G300 Managerial Economics (3 cr.) **12 cr.**

- II. Additional courses at the 300 - 400 level to total at least 16 credit hours.
Choose any one course from the following:

- F303 Intermediate Investment (3cr.)
- F446 Commercial Banks and Financial Intermediaries (3 cr.)
- F420 Investment (3 cr.)
- F494 International Finance (3 cr.)
- Or any upper level (300-400 level) economics course **3 cr.**

No grade below a C will be accepted in the Minor.

Students must also complete M118 Finite Mathematics with a grade of at least C (2.0). **3cr.**
