

Testing Center Honesty Policy

The Testing Center at IU East is committed to academic honesty, excellence, and integrity.

Academic Dishonesty:

Academic dishonesty is inappropriate and unacceptable behavior that will not be tolerated during testing. Academic dishonesty includes (but is not limited to) the following:

- Taking a test for another person
- Possessing or using unauthorized materials, notes, answer keys, during a test
- Copying from another person's test or sharing your own work with another examinee
- Stealing or attempting to steal a test booklet
- Failing to follow the orders given by the instructor or the proctor for the exam. For example, in an open book test, using notes, or in computerized test going to web sites other than the test site
- Failing to stop work when time is called
- Using materials other than those approved by testing administrators
- Failing to cooperate with testing administrators

Electronic Devices:

All electronic devices must be turned off before you enter the testing center.

Incidents of cheating require that a letter be written describing the incident; this will be sent to your instructor.
