- Be admitted as a degree-seeking student with tuition and fee charges above the VA's maximum in-state undergraduate rate as posted at www.gibill.va.gov

If you believe you are eligible, you should apply immediately. Awards to qualified applicants are on a first-come basis established by the date and time your application is received by the Office of Financial Aid and Scholarships.

You must provide follow-up documentation of your CH 33 Certificate of Eligibility OR proof of application for CH 33 plus your DD214. We will continue to accept applications until all slots are filled.

Funds will not be disbursed until our office receives a copy of your Certificate of Eligibility.
