16 weeks January 7 – April 29

October 29, 2018	Open registration begins for Spring & Summer 2019 terms.
November 1, 2018	Deadline to apply for May, June, or August 2019 graduation.
December 17, 2018	Intersession classes begin.
January 5, 2019	Intersession classes end.
January 7	SPRING CLASSES BEGIN.
Jan. 7—13	Late registration /schedule adjustment period. <i>Late registration fee in effect.</i>
January 13	Last day to register, add courses, or change sections. Final date to drop courses or to totally withdraw with no grade recorded. From January 14 through March 10, a grade of “W” will be recorded for all courses dropped.
January 13	Last day to drop or withdraw with a 100 percent refund.
January 21	Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Birthday—Holiday. Campus closed.
January 20	Last day to drop or withdraw with a 75 percent refund.
January 27	Last day to drop or withdraw with a 50 percent refund.
February 3	Last day to drop or withdraw with a 25 percent refund. No refund after this date.
February 5	Last day to drop a 1 st eight-week class with an auto “W.”
February 10	Fee payment due date.
February 25	1 st eight-week classes end.
February 26	2 nd eight-week classes begin.
March 10	Fee payment due date.
March 10	Final date to drop courses or totally withdraw from the University with an automatic “W.” (Drops after this date must be approved by the instructor and academic dean.)
March 11—17	Spring Break (campus is open but there are no classes).
March 18	Open registration for Fall 2019 term.
March 26	Last day to drop a 2 nd eight-week class with an auto “W.”
April 10	Fee payment due date.
April 15	Deadline to apply for December 2019 graduation.
